Do you think the advantages of working from home outweigh the disadvantages?

As a result of advancement in technology, people have this opportunity to work remotely .Some experts believe that this is very beneficial for society. While there are persuasive arguments in favor of remote working, I would argue that it is better to go to work.

On the one hand, some people believe that there are numerous advantages to working from home .From their point of view working from home can reduce traffic congestion which is one of the most <u>serious</u> concerns of governments these days.
